In response to the secondary consultation exercise in relation to the above, Causeway Health and Social Services Trust would make the following additional comments.

The Trust continues to endorse the broader scope of the strategy and renaming it as Anti Poverty Strategy. The Trust would continue to reiterate its view that rural deprivation in particular seems to lose significance under the current equation of Noble Indicators as outlined in our initial response and it will be interesting to see how the proposed statistical indicators take account of particular needs of people living in rural areas. In relation to skewing of resources, the Trust continues to hold the view that this approach is questionable and it is noted that this is further endorsed in Phase 2.
